# Valley Cities GeoTour 2019 PASSPORT



This year we expand our area to include the four cities of Auburn, Kent, Renton and Maple Valley - the Valley Cities. There are 40 new caches that will launch with a wide variety of types and sizes, Traditionals Multi-Caches, Puzzles, and a Gadget cache or two. Have fun along your adventures, and let the cache owners know you appreciate their work in this project.

Geocaching is a real-world, outdoor treasure hunt using GPS-enabled devices. Participants navigate to a specific set of GPS coordinates and then attempt to find the geocache container hidden at the location.

- Find these 40 geocaches and record their specific code word OR punch in this passport. Those finding all 40 will receive a Geocaching.com souvenir.
- Once you've completed this passport, you can receive a geocoin prize by filling out the form to the right and mailing it to the Valley Cities GeoTour address listed.
- We suggest you keep a copy of the completed passport in case it gets lost.
- Be sure to log your finds on the individual cache pages at [geocaching.com](http://geocaching.com) so we can read about your adventures!
- Geocoins are limited to one per family/ household while supplies last.
